The following is the rationale for how the games are scheduled.

The scheduler program came up with the following schedule statistics:

Home and away games were basically even as could be with 15 games:

The main issue is with handing out fields. There was a wide gap in how the fields were distributed

Riverdale, since it is the "hated" field was distributed the most "even".

The priority on the other fields was based on:

- 1) Bain was the only team with a preference for Greenwood, so I gave them the schedule that provided the most Greenwood games/
- 2) All other teams wanted Stanley Park, and it was agreed at the meeting that priority would be given in reverse order of last season's standings. That being the case:

**Redwood** finished 6<sup>th</sup> so were given the schedule with 7 Stanley games

**Badgers** finished 5<sup>th</sup> so were given one of the schedules with 6 Stanley games

**Bain** already were given the preferred Greenwood schedule

**Remnants** finished 3<sup>rd</sup> so were given the second schedule with 6 Stanley games

**Toronto Life** finished 2<sup>nd</sup> so were given the last schedule with 6 Stanley games

**Opera** finished first so were given the final schedule that only had 3 Stanley games.
